MADERA, CA. – District Attorney David A. Linn announced today that he will be attending the parole hearing of Frederick Woods, the last of the Chowchilla School Bus Kidnappers to remain in prison. The parole hearing is set for November 19, 2015, at the California Men’s Colony in San Luis Obispo.

The hearing will be held before the Board of Parole Hearings for the State of California. D.A. Linn will be working in conjunction with Jill Klinge, Deputy District Attorney of Alameda County.

D.A. Linn stated that he expected a number of victims of the Chowchilla kidnapping to attend the hearing and that he was hopeful that Mr. Woods’s parole would be denied.”
